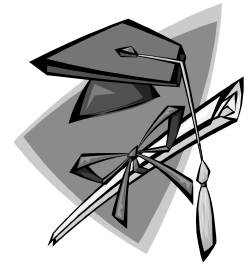

2. Applicants who are not dependents of, or who are not living with their parents/guardians, must complete this "Adult Continuing Education" form;
